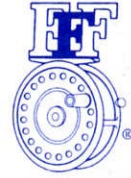

GUESTS ARE ALWAYS WELCOME

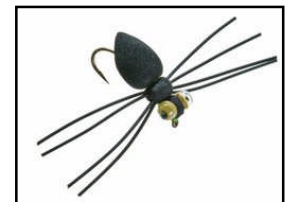
