Our meeting this month will feature Dick Turnbull from Tulsa who will tell us all about fly fishing for smallmouth bass in northeastern Oklahoma and northwest Arkansas. The native smallmouth bass in our area are some of the scrappiest fighters to catch on a fly rod. They prefer rocky streams typical of those found in the Ozarks and Ouachita, and they readily take sculpin, crayfish and other patterns. Join us this month for the Prairie Fly Fishers meeting.

Tom Adams will continue the Muddler series this month with the Conehead Kiwi Muddler. Muddlers are a sculpin and minnow pattern developed in the 1950's that are widely used for trout and steelhead. The Kiwi Muddler adds a conehead and rabbit strip for weight and silhouette to entice large fish from deeper water. Join the group at Backwoods for an evening of fly tying. Equipment is available if you don't have your own.
